Rules and Examples

Age 55+ ... must turn 55 in this year, born 1968 or earlier

Ball is played down – all putts must be holed – max score per hole is 8

2 Separate Divisions with Separate Gross & Net, standings

White Division – white tees, white handicaps

Green Division – green or blue tees, green handicap

Blue tee gross scores deduct 1 stroke

Player automatically entered, into both gross and net within respective division. Player posts 1 gross score per week, handicap is deducted from same score for net score and standings.

4 Days to post score ... Sunday, 1st day of the week, & Mon, Tue, Wed,

Once player declares his intent to post a league score, he can not try to better it on a later day, the same week
Book your own tee time, can play anytime of day with whomever, can be played in conjunction with other games, example – Bogey Club Wed group, Rat Pack, Men's Club weekly game etc. Before teeing off, player must declare his intent to post a BWSL score, either to a Pro Shop "staff personnel", similar rule as Men's Club weekly game, or to another BWSL member he is playing with.

Player must record, gross score and handicap in the league book.

If player posts a score with no or incorrect handicap, handicap will be 0

Book / Sheet will be in Pro shop.

No scores will be accepted after Wednesday or by other means example, phone, text or email.

Regular Season Points Structure ... each week

1st-20pts, 2nd 19, 3rd 18, 4th 17, 5th 16, 6th 15, 7th 14, 8th 13, 9th 12, 10th 11.

11th to 15th 8pts each, 16th to 20th 5pts each., post a score 2 pts.

Players split points if tied.

Regular Season Standings Average Points - Pts/Rds. – 10 Rd. Minimum

Example: Player A plays all 13 weeks and earns 159 pts, for an avg of 12.2.

Player B plays 10 weeks and earns, 130 pts, avg of 13.0 ... player B is ahead in standings.

Players who do not meet the minimum, 10 rounds, their point total will be divided by 10.

Example: End of regular season play, player C, only played 8 weeks, earned 106 pts, avg of 13.3, with 10 rd. min rule, point total is divided by 10, for a reduced standings avg of 10.6

Finishing Money – No double dip - Player can only receive \$ from one division. The higher amount or if tied, Gross amount.

Tie Breakers

Regular Season

- 1- Most Regular Season rounds played with posted score
- 2 – Lowest regular season scoring average for respective division

Top 4

- 1- Same as 1 above
- 2- Rd 2 playoff points gained.
- 3 Lowest Regular Season Scoring Average for respective division

Consolations

- 1- Same as 1 above
- 2- Lowest Regular Season Net Points Average
- 3 Lowest Regular Season Net Scoring Average

Gross Divisions / Net Finals

- 1 – Higher seed
